## Items Accepted - *This is not an exhaustive list; ask a volunteer if you have any questions!*

### We ask that items be clean and in working order, with all parts present.

- Baby Items - tubs, slings, strollers, pumps
- Books - hardcover, paperback, fiction, non-fiction, audio  
*All books must be in good condition: no mold, water damage, tears or highlighter marks  
No dictionaries, thesauruses, encyclopedias, text books, Time Life books or religious books*
- Craft Items
- Electronic equipment (*No tube TVs, monitors or outdated electronics*)
- Games (*complete with all pieces*)
- Home decor - knick-knacks, candles, picture frames and other like items
- Kitchenwares
- Lamps and lampshades
- Lotions, beauty items, new makeup
- Magazines (*within 12 months only*)
- DVD movies (*cannot be home-made or pirated*)
- Music cassettes, records or CDs (*cannot be home-made or pirated*)
- Office and school supplies
- Pet items - leashes, food bowls/dishes and small cages, etc
- Purses and wallets
- Small electronic appliances - coffee makers, vacuums, microwaves, blenders, etc
- Sports equipment
- Stuffed animals (*clean and in good condition*)
- Throw rugs, curtains, tablecloths
- Tools and toolboxes
- Toys (*in good condition and complete with all pieces*)
