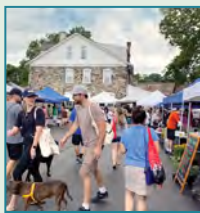

Local farmers who sell directly to consumers cut out the middleman and get full retail price for their food—which helps farm families stay on the land and they’re less likely to sell farmland for development. That is a matter of importance for food security, especially in light of an uncertain energy future and our current reliance on fossil fuels to produce, package, distribute, and store food.
